## **PRODUCT DESCRIPTION**


Clinker XL is a professional heavy duty tile cutter with a spring loaded base for shock absorbing effect. The machine has a large, graduated swivelling cutting guide and an extendable arm for supporting larger format tiles. The ball bearing scoring block allows for smooth, high precision cutting with a simple single action 'score & snap' cutting process. When moving the machine, use the carrying handle and wheels for ease of transport.

This manual must be kept in a safe place so that the information contained is always available. This operating manual must accompany the tile cutter if it is transferred to somebody else.

- 1. Cutting head carriage with ball bearings
- 2. Carriage support
- 3. Swivelling cutting guide
- 4. Big breaking foot

- 6. Tungsten carbide cutting wheel
- 7. Push bar
- 8. Shock absorbing trays
- 9. Base



## **HOW TO USE**

Before use, loosen the locking screw in the carriage support with the 5mm hex key provided to unlock the carriage.

Note: When moving or transporting the machine, ensure the carriage is locked.



Place the tile on the shock absorbing trays against the cutting guide. With the cutting point aligned, position the carriage and cutting wheel using the push bar.





When diagonal cutting, adjust the swivelling cutting guide to the required degree and then tighten the screws to fix the cutting guide in place

When the tile is in position, score the tile by exerting continuous downward pressure on the push bar along the entire length of the tile. After scoring a clear, continuous line along the tile, ensure the tile remains locked in position on the shock absorbing trays.


Put the breaking foot in position as indicated in Image 6. Generally, if the tile thickness is less than 10mm, then use the small breaking foot. If the tile thickness is more than 10mm, then use the big breaking foot.


When using the small breaking foot, gradually increase downward pressure until the tile is cut

## **MAINTENANCE**

Remove any dirt or residue from the carriage bar Note: Do not use any lubrication

Replace the cutting wheel if it is worn


Tighten the carriage lever, as indicated
