

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



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1.0 IMPORTANT NOTES

To ensure safe and stable installation:

- 1. The assembled Fire Surround must be fixed/ secure to the wall.
- 2. The wall must be sturdy and in good repair.
- 3. Some walls require alternative fixing (not included).
- 4. There are two options for constructions of the back panel.
- A Without a cut out
- B With a cut out

2.0 TOOLS REQUIRED

Cross head screw driver PZ2 (3 inches in length or greater)

Drill, and a 2mm suitable drill bit

Pencil

Tape measure





4.0 ASSEMBLY WITHOUT A CUT OUT






Gently lay all four back panels onto a suitable protected surface. Be extremely careful not to scratch the front edges of the back panels. DO NOT DRAG THE BACK PANELS! Make sure that the back panels are lifted every time they are moved to avoid them from being damaged. Ensure the back panels are all faced down. Place the top panel (1) above the 2x side panels (3, 4) that are either side of the middle panel (2). Once in the correct order, carefully slot all 4x panels together.



Once all 4x panels have been positioned correctly, Offer the fixing plates (A) into position, as per the above. Make with a pencil all 24x hole positions, remove the fixing plates (A) and drill a 2mm hole 6mm deep in all 24x positions, then place the 6x fixing brackets (A) back into position and carefully screw all 24x 4x12mm screws (B) into place with a cross headed screw driver.

4.0 ASSEMBLY WITHOUT A CUT OUT - CONTINUED




Carefully turn the back panel around so the front is facing forward, then install the back panel on to the rear of the chosen surround.

Ensure the hearth is in the correct orientation and position, then carefully lift the back panel and surround on to the hearth. Feed any wires through before fixing the surround in place.


5.0 ASSEMBLY - WITH A CUT OUT





Gently lay all four back panels onto a suitable protected surface. Be extremely careful not to scratch the front edges of the back panels. DO NOT DRAG THE BACK PANELS! Make sure that the back panels are lifted every time they are moved to avoid them from being damaged. Ensure the back panels are all faced down. Place the top panel (I) above the 2x side panels (3, 4). Once in the correct order, carefully slot all 3x panels together.



Once all 3x panels have been positioned correctly, Offer the fixing plates (A) into position, as per the above. Make with a pencil all 16x hole positions, remove the fixing plates (A) and drill a 2mm hole 6mm deep in all 16x positions, then place the 4x fixing brackets (A) back into position and carefully screw all 16x 4x12mm screws (B) into place with a cross headed screw driver.



Carefully turn the back panel around so the front is facing forward, then install the back panel on to the rear of the chosen surround.

Ensure the hearth is in the correct orientation and position, then carefully lift the back panel and surround on to the hearth. Feed any wires through before fixing the surround in place.

6.0 CLEANING/FINISHING



Before carrying out any of the following operations, ensure that the appliance is OFF and completely cold. Regularly clean around the appliance to ensure that dust, fluff, pet hair etc, are kept to a minimum. There are no other specific requirements for care, other than regular cleaning of the general appliance.

A wipe with a dry cloth is normally sufficient. **DO NOT** use abrasive cleaners as they can damage the finish. Test on a hidden part before cleaning. Clean only in the direction of the grain. Regularly check the surround is securely fixed in position.

7.0 GUARANTEE - TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The 3 year guarantee commences from the date of purchase, provided that the terms and conditions are adhered to:
